Show Regulations

1. **JURISDICTION:** The Show will be held under the licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. as in force on the 1st January 2012
2. The Show will be held on Saturday the 7th of April 2012
3. **REGISTRATION etc.** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club. Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without further registration.
4. **VENUE:** The Show will be held in the **National Show Centre, Cloghran.**
5. **ENTRY FEES:** The entry fee will be based on the following scale:-

Breed Class	€24.00 (£24.00 Stg.) for 1st dog
Additional Dogs	€10.00 (£10.00 Stg.) each.
Dogs Not For Competition	€5.00 (£5.00) Each
All Stakes Classes	€10.00 (£10.00 Stg.) per dog per class
Open Ch. Obedience	€12.00 (£12.00 Stg.) per dog
All Other Obedience Classes	€6.00 (£6.00 Stg.) per dog per class
Junior Handling	Free if entered in Breed otherwise €5.00 (£5.00 Stg.)
Car Park	€4.00 (£4.00 Stg.) prepaid or €5.00 (£5.00 Stg.) on Day
Catalogue	€4.00 (£4.00 Stg.) prepaid or €5.00 (£5.00 Stg.) on Day

Fees of exhibitors arriving late or failing to arrive will be forfeited. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.

REJECTING ENTRIES etc.: The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the catalogue or allocation of stand space at the show.

INELIGIBLE ENTRIES: A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by

the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging, but in no other respects.

ENTRY FORMS (mistakes in): The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by exhibitors and while every endeavour will be made to have forms correctly interpreted, the promoting body cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes therein.

6. Prize cards will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd and reserve in each class. Rosettes will be given to Green Star, Best of Breed, Groups 1st to 4th places, Best in Show to 4th place, also 1st to 4th in Junior Handling, and Obedience.
7. **VETERINARY EXAMINATION:** The Veterinary Surgeon on call will have the power to exclude any exhibit which in his opinion is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of Disease, lice or other cause.
8. **EXHIBITS:**
 - (a) Each exhibitor shall be responsible to keep their exhibits under proper control at all times.
 - (b) Every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent not later than 7 pm
9. **JUDGING:** Judging **will commence at 8.30 a.m.** No claim will be considered in the event of any exhibit being late.
 - (a) No person will be allowed in the Judging ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an Exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.
 - (b) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the judging ring.
 - (c) The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring at the time of judging.
10. **SPECIAL PRIZES** offered by a specialist Club must be collected from that Club.
11. **ALL ANNOUNCEMENTS** appearing in the Dog Papers and on www.DogShowEntry.ie website; prior to the date of closing of entries and in reference to any alterations made by the committee in the schedule or in these regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
12. **ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE:** The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.

ALL PREPAIDS MUST BE COLLECTED BY 11 am.

OBEDIENCE CLASS DEFINITIONS

PRE -BEGINNERS Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded a first prize (on or under 10 marks) in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by The Irish Kennel Club.

BEGINNERS Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or awarded three or more first prizes (**on or under 10 marks**) in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by The Irish Kennel Club.

NOVICE Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (**on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations**) in any Obedience class other than in Beginners Obedience class.

CLASS (A) OBEDIENCE (GRADUATE) Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (**on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations**) in any Obedience Class other than in Beginners and Novice Obedience classes.

CLASS (B) OBEDIENCE (LIMIT) Confined to dogs which have not been awarded a Green Star or four or more first prizes (**on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations**) in any Obedience Classes with the exception of Beginners, Novice or Graduate Obedience classes.

CLASS (C) CH. OBEDIENCE (OPEN) Open to all.

OBEDIENCE will commence at 9.30 A.M.

BEST BABY PUPPY IN SHOW

In addition to the standard Groups, there will be **A Baby Puppy Group** in which all Best Baby Puppy in Breed will challenge for Best Baby Puppy In Show.

The Best Baby Puppy in each breed will be eligible to compete in this Group.

BEST PUPPY IN SHOW

In addition to the standard Groups, there will be **A Puppy Group** in which all Best Puppy in Breed will challenge for Best Puppy In Show.

The Best Puppy in each breed will be eligible to compete in this Group.

BEST VETERAN IN SHOW

In addition to the standard Groups, there will be **A Veteran Group** in which all Best Veterans in Breed will challenge for Best Veteran in Show.

The Best Veteran in each breed (unless it wins Best of it's own Breed) will be eligible to compete in this Group.

If a Veteran wins Best of it's own Breed it will not be eligible to compete in the Veteran Group, but will proceed like All Best of Breed winners to compete in the standard group

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

Exercise pens/puppy pens are prohibited at all shows licensed by the Irish Kennel Club.

NO CAGES OR TABLES WILL BE ALLOWED AT RING SIDE BEFORE THE SHOW IS OPENED

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
3. No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
5. Groups will be divided into ten sections - as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
7. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. to 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
8. Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
9. If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited the day. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

Notice for schedule

The Stakes Classes scheduled at this Show are separate from the Breed Judging and do not come under the rules of the Green Star System, e.g. An exhibit which has been beaten in a Stakes Class but wins Best of Breed may proceed to compete in its relevant Group.

All exhibits who wish to enter Stakes Classes must be entered in their relevant Breed Classes with the exception of Champions/Veterans who may enter the Stakes Class only.

A separate judge other than the Best in Show or Group judge must be used for stakes classes (Best in Show qualified) **(effective from the 1st January 2011)**

ORDER OF JUDGING

Proposed order and starting time of judging will be enclosed with Ring Numbers to All Exhibitors.

OUT DOOR RINGS

Obedience, German Shepherds, Boxers, Great Danes and Irish Wolfhounds will be **Judged Out Doors. Weather permitting** other suitable breeds may also be judged outdoors.

(see notice accompanying Ring Numbers)

Where possible we will have Tented Cover for Outdoor Breeds

Dogs from other FCI Countries that have attained the title of CHAMPION in their own country and who win a Green Star at an International Show in Ireland will be awarded an Irish Kennel Club Championship title.

Cropped dogs are not permitted to be exhibited at any Irish Kennel Club licensed vent.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR

Irish Kennel Club C.A.C.I.B. and Green Star Show

The F.C.I. require that Judges must compare each individual exhibit to their standard and grade them accordingly. Dogs of exceptional quality are considered for C.A.C.I.B. (Int. Certificate) and Green Star (National Certificate).

1. **Grading:** After each examination all dogs must be graded one of the following by the judge i.e. "E" (Excellent), "V.G." (Very Good). "G" (Good), "S" (Sufficient) Cannot be judged or Disqualified and Puppy Grading: Promising, Very Promising, Sufficient and Cannot be judged. **Each exhibitor will be given a Grading Card by the Steward.**

2. **Green Star (National Title)** Only unbeaten dogs **Graded Excellent** are eligible to challenge for the Green Star.
 Reserve Green Star: **Reserve Green Star:** Confined to dogs beaten only by the Green Star Winner and **Graded Excellent.**

3. **C.A.C.I.B. and Reserve:** Confined to the winners of the Intermediate, Open and Champion's class graded **Excellent**

4. a. Where a dog under 15 months wins a Green Star and is not eligible for the C.A.C.I.B. the Judge Must award it to another qualified dog.
 b. All grades and awards must be completed by the Judge in the Judges book

5. **Best Puppy in Breed** Confined to puppies entered in puppy class who have been awarded the **Grade of Very Promising**

6. **Best Veteran in Breed** Confined to dogs entered in the veteran class who have been awarded the **Grade of Excellent**

Competition for Green Star and/or CACIB

- The **Junior** Class winners that have been graded Excellent Grades will **compete** for the **Green Star** but **NOT for the CACIB**.
- The **Intermediate** Class winner if **Graded Excellent** will **compete** for the **Green Star** and the **CACIB**.
- The winners of the **Open** Class and **Champions** Class, if **Graded Excellent** will compete for the **Green Star** and the **CACIB**.
- The winner of the **Veteran** Class, if **Graded Excellent** will compete for the **Green Star** but **NOT for the CACIB**
- The Puppy Class winners that are **Graded Very Promising** will compete for **Best Puppy in Breed**, will be chosen after the Best of Breed, and will go onto compete in the Main Ring for **“Best Puppy In Group” Only**
- The Veteran Class winners that are Graded Excellent will compete for **Best Veteran in Breed**, will be chosen after the Best of Breed competition. Winners will compete in the Main Ring for **“Best Veteran in Show”**.

Breeds not separately listed at International Championship Shows

All Breeds qualified by the FCI to compete for the International Beauty Title must be afforded the opportunity to do so at All Breed International Shows. In order to facilitate this, the Any Variety Class is replaced by a class entitled **Breeds Not Listed** which must be scheduled in each of the ten groups.

Entries received in this class must be divided into breed sections. A Judge may award a CACIB, Green Star, and Best of Breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible, if in his/her opinion they are of sufficient quality.

When entries are received, Judges for these classes will be allocated by the show promoting body and exhibitors informed when they are sent their ring numbers. The names of the judges will be listed in the catalogue.

INTERNATIONAL BEAUTY CHAMPION

The Irish Kennel Club can only apply to the F. C. I. for this title in respect of Dogs Owned by Irish Residents. All others must apply directly to their own National Kennel Club.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

A Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under nine months of age on the day of the Show.

(Puppies may not compete for the Green Star or CACIB)

A Junior Class is for dogs over nine and under eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth. **(Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to compete for the CACIB but may compete for the Green Star)**

An Intermediate Class is for dogs over 15 and under 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show.

Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club rules or under another recognized Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries. *

Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show **(Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to compete for the CACIB)**

* Please note – a Veteran Dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.*

Working Classes To enter a dog in working class, the entry form must be accompanied by a copy of the FCI compulsory certificate containing the confirmation -by the member country in which the holder and/or owner has his permanent place of residence- that the dog has passed the test as well as details about this test. The only breeds eligible for the working class are those appearing as working breeds in the FCI Breed Nomenclature, taking into account the exceptions granted to some countries for some breeds.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in **ONE BREED CLASS ONLY** (No double entries)

The decisive date in respect of age is the day the dog is shown.

The Japanese Akita

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds; American Akita and Akita Inu - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed. (Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 American Akita and Class 3 Akita Inu/American Akita (not yet assessed))

At all shows where there are entries of un-assessed Akitas, They will be assessed on the day and transferred to the correct breed dogs prior to the judging of the breeds.

Videos

It is a Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring on the day.
